2 years ago, I took on the Manager of Events, working with a team of members to organise an Event every month. We have fun and I know the members appreciate it. That's a lot of Volunteer hours put in by this committee.

GREENS ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

Work commencing late September/early October 2023

This recently Board approved project, inclusive of planned renovations, will be executed with consideration to all logistic and time constraints. It will improve/correct the quality of the running surface associated with levels and thatch reduction, with an emphasis on consistency and trueness, on all four greens over the next 18 -24 months.

We predict results to be better than previous attempts, due to the improved watering system being utilised to its fullest potential, preventing pooling and trafficking.

Allowing for improved growing conditions post dormancy in late September/early October, the A green will be scarified and laser levelled initially, to avoid excessive disruption to greens loadings associated with social/pennant bowls requirements.

Once the recovery process is evident on A green in mid to late November, the green will come back into play, allowing the enhancement project to continue with B green being deep cored, scarified and laser levelled.

B green will be back in play and ready for the commencement of practice and play for the first pennant game in the New Year of 2024. This will coincide with a minor refurbishment of C green during the Christmas break, entailing scarification, aeration, topdressing and fertilising with soil amendments.

A and D green will be available during the Xmas and New Year period for practice, whilst B and C green are given adequate time to recover.


D green will be renovated in the 2024/25 season, allowing for full recovery once the neighbouring encroaching tree has been adequately cut back and maintained.

The team at D & D are looking forward to seeing the results and appreciate the ongoing support from Members in embracing the shared goal of enhancing the greens at the Hawthorn Bowling Club.


